

From the Office of President Bordeaux:

We will have updated figures tomorrow, but it is apparent that not enough people are taking this threat seriously.

More people need to be wearing masks.

My office has received reports that people are not cooperating with our CHR tracers. CHR is only interested in who people have had contact with someone who was possibly infected. This is designed to protect the public and offer support to people. Those not cooperating are doing the public a disservice and potentially endangering our relatives. We are exploring legal avenues to compel their cooperation.

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY!!!

I. If you are outside of your home or vehicle, you are required to wear a facemask covering your nose and mouth. Failure to do so may result in a citation for \$25 per instance.

II. Essential Employees working in stores and other public places are required to wear facemasks at their workstations.

III. Businesses are directed to not allow anyone in their facility who is not wearing a facemask.

IV. Grocery stores are directed to only allow ten (10) people at a time in their stores. Only one person per household in a store at one time.

V. Gas stations may only have seven (7) patrons at a time. Only one person per household in a gas station at one time.

VI. Businesses will need to have someone at the door to make sure these standards are followed. If you have more than one entrance, people will need to come in only one door and out the other door. One way in, the other door is exit only.

Businesses not implementing these may be subject to a civil penalty up to \$1000 and/or the loss of their business license.

Our businesses have been cooperating and helping the community and we are grateful. Unfortunately, we need to get stricter.
